If you are interested at knowing my <u>h-index</u> (currently: **17**), you can find me via Google Scholar here. (But do read the San Francisco Declaration on Research Assessment DORA warning against an excessive use of such indexes and related metrics.) If you are interested at knowing my <u>academic age</u> you should <u>deduct 8.5 years</u> from my <u>biological age</u>, due to: (i) non-academic employment after my M.A. degree and before the start of the doctorate (2000–2004: 4 years at 100%); (ii) political activity in elected office and volunteering in associations (for the common good, or so I claim; 2004–2013: 9 years at 30%, i.e. a total of 3 years); (iii) care duties (three children, born 2012, 2014 and 2016; 20% since then; i.e. a total of approx. 1.5 years). Hence, as of September 2021 my academic age is **37**.
